COMMUNICATION AT ELMLEY



Communication is key to us at Elmley, and we're working hard to streamline our systems to be as efficient as possible. We understand that schools, like your own lives, are fast-paced and busy. Therefore, we aim to provide you with essential information in a way that allows us to focus on your children rather than on administration. We also recognise the importance of minimising excessive emails. As working parents or parents with busy commitments, we know that too many emails can lead to important details being missed, which we want to avoid.

As we start the school year, here's a reminder of how we'll communicate with you to ensure clear and efficient communication:

On the gate: A staff member will greet and dismiss your child. This is a great time to pass on any important information. Mrs Penney and Mrs Hay (our new office administrator) will be available too in case you need to ask questions or pass over any information.

Fortnightly Newsletters: These are sent every other Friday. These will include details of upcoming events, updates in school and will act a place to celebrate our children too. If anything urgent arises between newsletters, we'll send you a separate email. We frequently receive calls and emails requesting information already provided in our newsletter. Please take a moment to read it to stay informed.

Appointments: If you need a longer discussion with your child's teacher, please email office@elmleycastle.worcs.sch.uk, and the teacher will be happy to arrange a meeting or phone call.

Class Dojo: Your child will come home today with a login for Class Dojo. This tool allows us to share important learning moments through photos, videos, and updates. It also serves as a platform for class and school reminders.

Class Dojo is secure, and only those with a login can access the class page. If you prefer not to have your child's photo featured, please email the office, and we'll ensure their teacher is informed.

To support our teachers' work-life balance, the messaging feature on Class Dojo will be turned off. Please use the other communication methods mentioned above.

READING AT ELMLEY

At Elmley Castle, reading remains a key focus across the school as we recognise its vital role in shaping success in the wider curriculum. Last term, we were delighted to see the enthusiasm and dedication to reading both at school and at home. We hope this excitement continues as we move forward into the new term!

To support our ongoing whole-school reading drive, here are some updates and reminders for our new starters and the wider Elmley Castle family:

Book Changes: Books will now be changed twice a week, on Tuesdays and Thursdays, for all classes. This may slightly differ for children who are free reading and are reading lengthy books. Due to reading assessments taking place, home reading books will be sent home on Tuesday.

Reading Levels: Each child will receive one book appropriate to their reading level. Your child's level will continue to be informed by regular phonics assessments and reading assessments with their class teacher.

Love for Reading: We encourage all children to develop a lifelong love of reading, so please continue to share books that are read for pleasure at home as well!

Reading Records: We will be checking reading records every Tuesday morning in all classes. To help us track how much reading is being done at home, please 'make a mark' in your child's reading record each time you listen to them read. This could be a simple signature or a brief comment. The expectation remains that all children read at least four times a week at home. This will be monitored by your child's class teacher on a Tuesday, and children who meet this goal will get the chance to receive a reward.

Book Bands: Book bands have recently been updated, so your child's reading band colour may have changed to reflect this. If you have any questions, please don't hesitate to ask.

As always, please ensure that books and reading records are in school every day. Together, let's continue to nurture a love for reading that will benefit our children across the curriculum and beyond.


