Who can attend the talk?

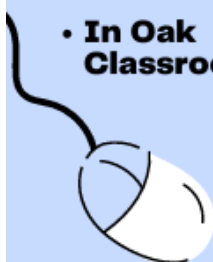
Only adults can attend the talk as it includes topics which are sensitive.

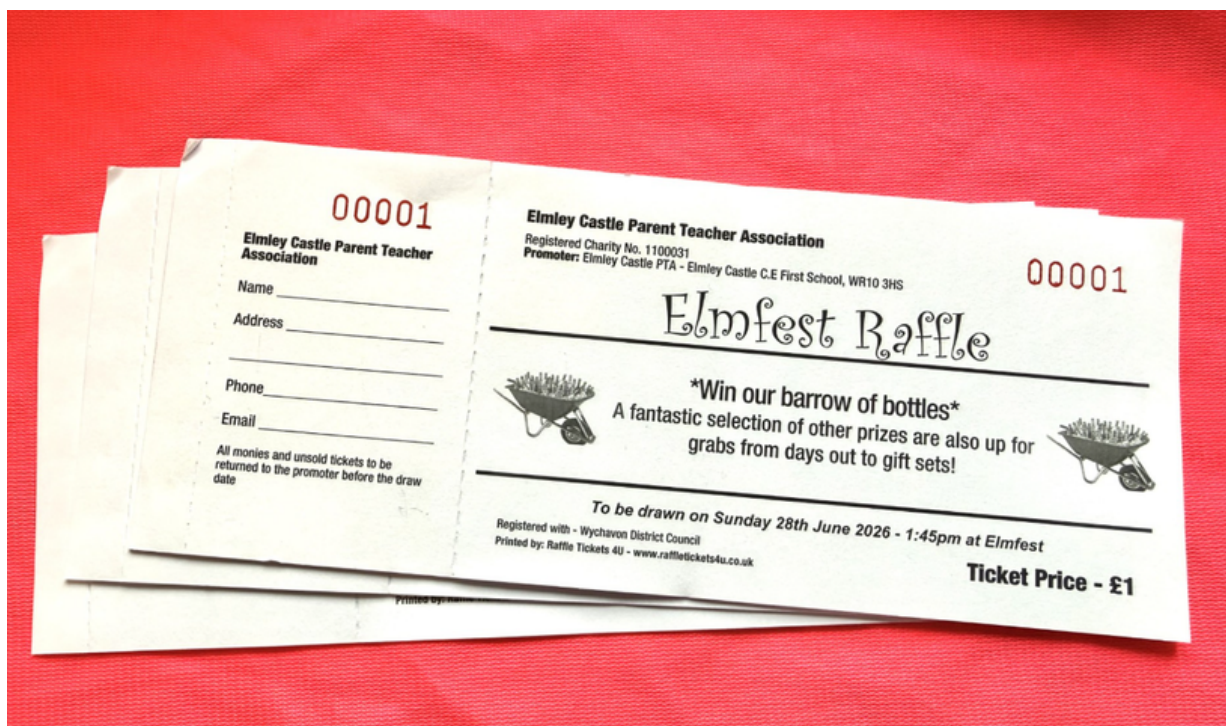
